# **Alternative to Senior Ditch Day!**

Tuesday, February 16, 2010 is the school approved "senior ditch day." If your "senior" son/daughter will not be in school that day, please call the school office to let us know.

As an alternative, a servant event is set up for that day for seniors at Opportunity Village's Ralph and Betty Engelstad Campus at 6050 S. Buffalo. Opportunity Village is a not-for-profit organization that serves people with intellectual disabilities by providing them with vocational training, employment and social recreation services that make their lives more productive and interesting.

For those seniors that are interested in this wonderful servant event, we will board the Faith Lutheran bus at 8:30 am on Tuesday, February 16th in the student parking lot on the west side of the gym. Upon arrival at Opportunity Village, we will be given a tour of the campus. Then each student will be able to choose from several programs based on their interest level.

These programs will range from reading and playing games with intellectually disabled citizens to working with highly functioning individuals in the Employment Training Center.

We will serve at Opportunity Village until 11:30 am. We will then board the bus and head to Red Rock Resort and Casino to enjoy a buffet lunch together at The Feast Buffet. The cost for the buffet including tax and tip will be \$12; this is the only money students will need. Students should bring cash – exact change would be awesome! We should return to the Faith parking lot no later than 1:30 pm. Students who don't wish to eat at Red Rock can be dropped off at FL by noon; they obviously will not need any money for the day.
